Skin Disease

+Fleas

Demodex/ +Scabies/+cheyletiella / +Bedbugs (?)

Upper Respiratory Infection

Viral = Feline Herpes and Feline Calicivirus

Bacterial = Mycoplasma, +Bordatella, +Chlamydia

Infectious Diarrhea

“Worms” =+Roundworms and Tapeworms

Protozoa=+Giardia, Coccidia, Trichomonas, +Cryptosporidium

Bacterial= +Salmonella, E.coli, +Campylobacter, +Clostridium

Viral= Feline Panleukopenia, Feline Corona virus

Feline Immune Deficiency Virus (FIV)

Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV)

Feline Corona Virus (FCoV)—Feline Infectious Peritonitis (FIP)
